For the second year in a row we set many records, thanks to your participation and generous donation in support of *Tree of Lights 2006*.

- 10% increase in dollars raised
- 932 donors purchased more than 1,348 lights
- 53% of total dollars raised came from Veteran Service Organizations
- 9% of all donors were SSVC alumni
- Pennsylvania's 151 Fallen Military Personnel from Operation Iraqi Freedom were remembered with a light
