A Colorado Rocky Mountain experience to remember!

The charge for this evening will be approximately \$75.00 per person which includes gondola ride, food, taxes and gratuity, but does NOT include beverages.

#### DIRECTIONS TO DER FONDUE CHESSEL:

- I-70 to exit 205 Silverthorne
- Highway 6 towards Keystone Resort
- Drive through Keystone Resort and turn right at Gondola Road sign.
- Turn left onto Gondola Road
- Turn right into "Montezuma Free Parking Lot"
- Walk through the center of River Run Village towards the mountain
- Board the River Run Gondola and enjoy 20 minute ride to the summit of Keystone's Dercum Mountain
- Exit Gondola and walk across summit to the Outpost Gondola and enjoy the 20 minute ride to North Peak
- Der Fondue Chessel is located in the Outpost Lodge and is the second door on the left.

Featuring a four course menu, Der Fondue Chessel is located at 11,444' atop North Peak at the Outpost Lodge. Dinner starts with a cheese fondue, followed by Caesar salad, your choice of meats or vegetables to grill raclette style, and finishes with chocolate fondue.

Dinner takes approximately two hours while the Gondola to the Outpost Lodge takes approximately 40 minutes each way.

Notes from Der Fondue Chessel:

- Everyone traveling back to the Outpost restaurants must be at least 3 years of age or older.
- \*Reservations are for 7:30, so we need to meet at the bottom of the River Run Gondola in the Center of River Run Village at Keystone Resort NO LATER THAN 6:30 p.m.
- You will be traveling to a remote back country area on an unheated aerial tramway. Please come dressed to withstand cold temperatures and extreme winter weather conditions. For your comfort and safety, warm, layered clothing is required including insulated winter coats, hats, and gloves.
- Please wear winter outdoor footwear designed for use in cold and snowy conditions. Street shoes including high heels and smooth soled loafers are not appropriate for this environment.
- Be advised that traveling from 9,280 to 11,444 feet in 40 minutes time may increase the effects of altitude sickness. Those with heart problems, pulmonary disease or similar health issues may be more susceptible to the effects of altitude sickness.
- Please be advised that because of the remote location of the restaurant, there is limited access to and/or a potential for delay of emergency medical response.
- Unexpected weather conditions can cause gondola closures. In extremely adverse conditions when the gondolas cannot operate there may be the possibility of an overnight stay at the restaurant.
