Dear Classmates:

As I am writing this it is 25 years to the day from when we graduated and, as the calendar works, the class of 2006 graduated on exactly the same date and also had the President speak at their graduation. It was a great day and we are looking forward to celebrating the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our graduation during the first weekend of September this fall. We have already had over 190 classmates sign up so far and we hope that you will use this opportunity to sign up as well.

Enclosed find the **Event/Registration Form** you must return to sign up for meals and events. To sign up for **Golf** or to order **Memorabilia** and **Football Tickets** refer to the enclosures. Additionally, please find copies of the current lists of **Classmates Registered** and **Lost Classmates** and a copy of the **Agenda** for the weekend. We have also included a **Menu Sheet** to assist in making your meal decisions. Note: If you did not register for the reunion earlier, you may do so now (last chance!). This is the last mailing to go out to the entire class.

**EVENT AND REGISTRATION FEES: The registration deadline is** <u>August 5th</u>. Complete the enclosed **Event Registration** form and mail in the enclosed envelope to: Class of 81 Reunion, PO Box 620, Skaneateles, NY 13152. Be sure to include the required \$150 registration fee if you have not already done so. Refunds of this fee are available until 1 July and event/meal money refunds are available until 12 August. The registration fee covers mailings, bus transportation all 3 days (on and around West Point as well as round trip from the hotel), administrative costs, down payments, and certain reunion mementos, which will be issued at registration. Upon arrival, your registration packet will include tickets for the events you paid for in addition to a class baseball cap, a class tote bag, a copper class mug, a lapel pin, key chain and lanyards with name badge. **Class widows are encouraged to attend and are not required to pay the registration fee.** Checks should be made out to the <u>Class of '81 Reunion</u>. Please note that meal events require a ticket and only an extremely limited number will be available for purchase at the door. Also, see on the web a list of area restaurants in the vicinity that can be used for cadet company events or other group gatherings which you may want to coordinate for Saturday evening.

**PARKING/TRANSPORTATION:** Please note that parking on West Point is very limited. Those planning to drive to West Point will be required to clear security via the Thayer or Stoney gates and park at Buffalo Soldiers Field or the old PX parking lot—and then walk or shuttle bus to Central Area. Washington Gate is for DOD sticker holders with Government ID card. There is NO PARKING for our class in Central Area. We strongly recommend taking the buses on Friday and Saturday. Please indicate on the event sign up form how many in your party will use the buses on each day so we can order the correct number of buses.

**FOOTBALL TICKETS:** Order by **12 August** using the separate form to order seats in the class reunion section. Mail the form directly to the Army Ticket Office, Holleder Center, West Point, NY 10996. Orders may also be placed by calling the ticket office directly at 845-446-4996 or at the AAA web site, <u>www.goarmysports.com</u> and click on tickets. Payment can be made by credit card and checks made payable to "Army Athletic Association". The ticket office will mail out tickets two weeks prior to the game or you can request they hold them at the will call window for pickup on game day or Friday of the reunion. **The new** 

## ESPN television contract allows them to change the scheduled 1pm game start time up to twelve days out. We will adjust our agenda accordingly if necessary.

**MEMORABILIA**: Use the separate enclosed form to place your orders for memorabilia. Payments can be made using a credit card or checks payable to "Everywear." Mail the form to Everywear, P.O. A class baseball cap, a class tote bag, a copper class mug, a lapel pin, key chain and lanyards with name badge are included with your registration fee and will be provided at registration.

**LODGING**: We have a block of rooms reserved at the Woodcliff Lakes Hilton in Montvale, NJ, which is the official site the reunion (same location as our 10<sup>th</sup> reunion). The hotel is located just off the Garden State Parkway, very close to the intersection of the New York State Thruway and the Palisades Parkway, on the West Point side of the Hudson River. The special room rate at **Woodcliff Lakes Hilton** is \$115 per night (plus tax) single or double occupancy and will only be held until 7 August at 5 p.m. Their number is **201-391-3600** or (800) HILTONS and ask for the "West Point 1981 reunion" rate.

**GOLF:** Ray Lilly has agreed to organize a class golf tournament at West Point on Thursday of our reunion weekend. The outing begins with a light continental breakfast followed by shotgun start. <u>AGENDA/DRESS</u>: The enclosed agenda lists the times and events for the weekend. Thursday evening's supper reception is golf casual (sport shirts and slacks or equivalent). Friday daytime activities are casual dress with comfortable walking shoes. The agenda allows time for touring the Central Area, visiting Nininger Hall, the newly renovated Arvin Gym, and shopping in the usually "closed to the public" Cadet Store. The Friday evening dinner/dance will be a dressy affair (suits or sport coats for the men, equivalent attire for women). On Saturday, Class A's, a sport coat, or equivalent attire is expected for classmates as the corps will be paying their respects to us at the parade. We'll also wear the class ball cap included in the registration packet to the parade. We will have Lincoln Hall (near the soccer field) open for people to change out of Class A's after the photo. Guests can be in casual attire—in their "as for football" dress for all Saturday events.
