For Graduates

- Free full-service POP e-mail account with webmail access
  - Free personal web page
  - Graduate Living History Project
  - Free web hosting and e-mail listserver for USMA classes, West Point Societies, Corps/Club Squad Athletics Alumni, and other groups approved by the WP-ORG Board of Advisors.
  - Reunion web sites for dynamic content (e.g., stories, web forums)
  - Credit card processing for reunions, society events, and other fund-raisers (subject to a 5% transaction fee)
  - Eulogy pages for remembering deceased graduates
