- 9:00 am Parade/Review on the Plain
- 12:00 pm GAME!!
- End of 3rd Quarter, we need all grillmasters to return to the tailgate site to fire up the grill and begin cooking. Also, if any people are bringing dishes which require advance preparation, we ask they report at this time. We want to have the food ready at the end of the game.
- During tailgate Serving volunteers are to replenish food items and beverages in coolers, and restock paper products. Keep serving areas clean.
- 7:00 pm Tailgate concludes. We ask cleanup volunteers to pack surplus food for cadets, break down tables/chairs, take equipment to vehicles, and collect garbage.
