Dear Recently Commissioned Officer:

I would like to extend a personal invitation to you to join your fellow officers of all services as a member of the Army Navy Country Club without the usual payment of initiation fees. (Normal initiation fees range from \$1,000 for junior officers to \$25,000 for retired officers.)

Army Navy Country Club is a private organization, which was established in 1924 to provide recreational facilities for commissioned officers. The Club features two outstanding golf courses, 21 tennis courts and four large swimming pools at two prime locations in Virginia near Washington, D.C.

If you accept as an Absentee member, dues are \$150.00 annually and entitle you* to utilize the full facilities of the Club 15 days per calendar year whenever passing through the area or when on TDY. If, however, you accept as an Inactive Resident member, your use of Club facilities is limited to upstairs dining at Arlington, the Fairfax Grill, and attendance at Club-sponsored functions. An Inactive Resident member is permitted occasional use of the athletic facilities as the guest of a Resident, Absent, or Temporary member. Dues for an Inactive Resident member are \$300.00 annually.

You must decide to take advantage of this invitation within the first year of your commissioning while serving on active duty in the lowest rank in your service or corps, and have an active duty commitment of at least two years, in order to qualify for this exemption from payment of initiation fees. Please complete the application on the reverse side and return it along with the applicable dues and copies of your commissioning certificate and latest orders.
