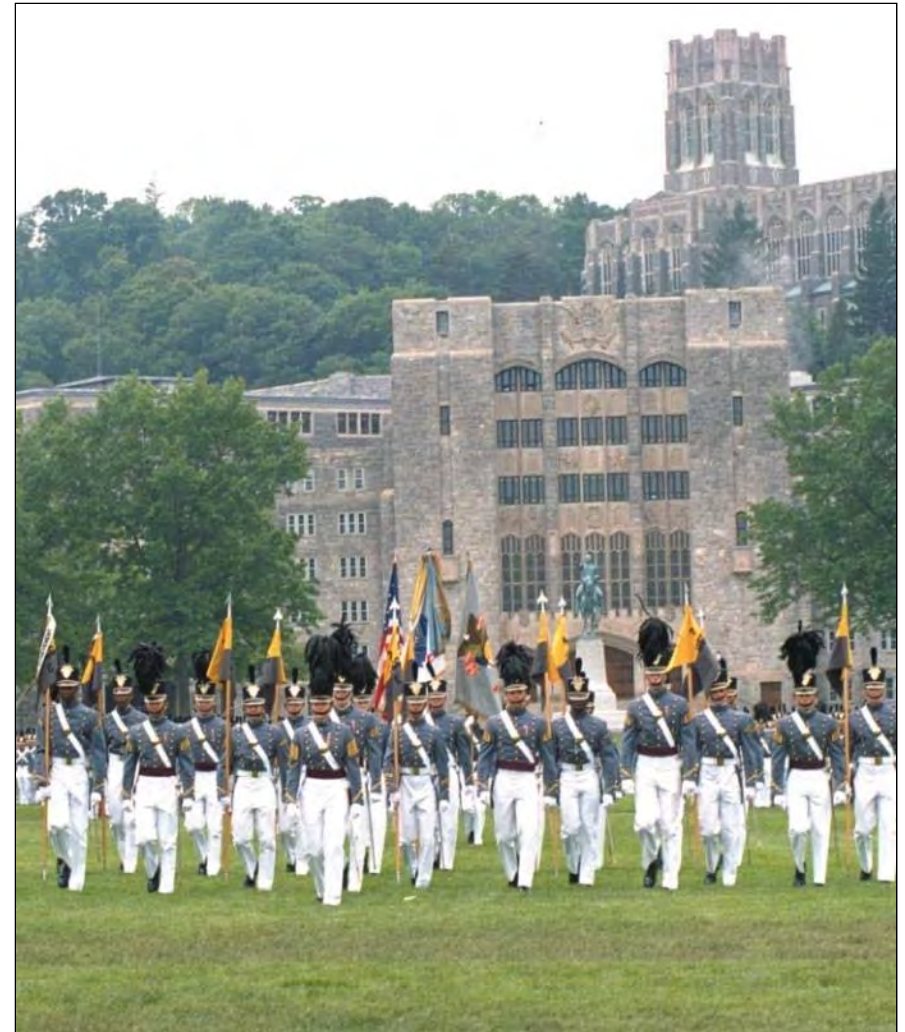


Vision
