



For the 'Hole in One' page, I have experienced the phenomenon twice. The first time was in 1984 on the 9th hole at West Point Golf Course (hole is about 185 yds and club was 5 wood...not sure of date...believe it was May...exact date is inscribed on the Hole in One plaque that is now on the wall along the staircase descending to the Men's Room at the course...the location is believed to be a statement about the prowess of some whose names are listed!! The second time was about 2000 on the 15th hole at Indian Pines GC in Auburn AL. The hole is about 165 yds and I used a 5 iron that day. Exact date, etc, is not known now as their Hole in One plaque was destroyed when the clubhouse burned down in 2006. [I may have kept the scorecard, but Lord only knows where I would have put it.]
