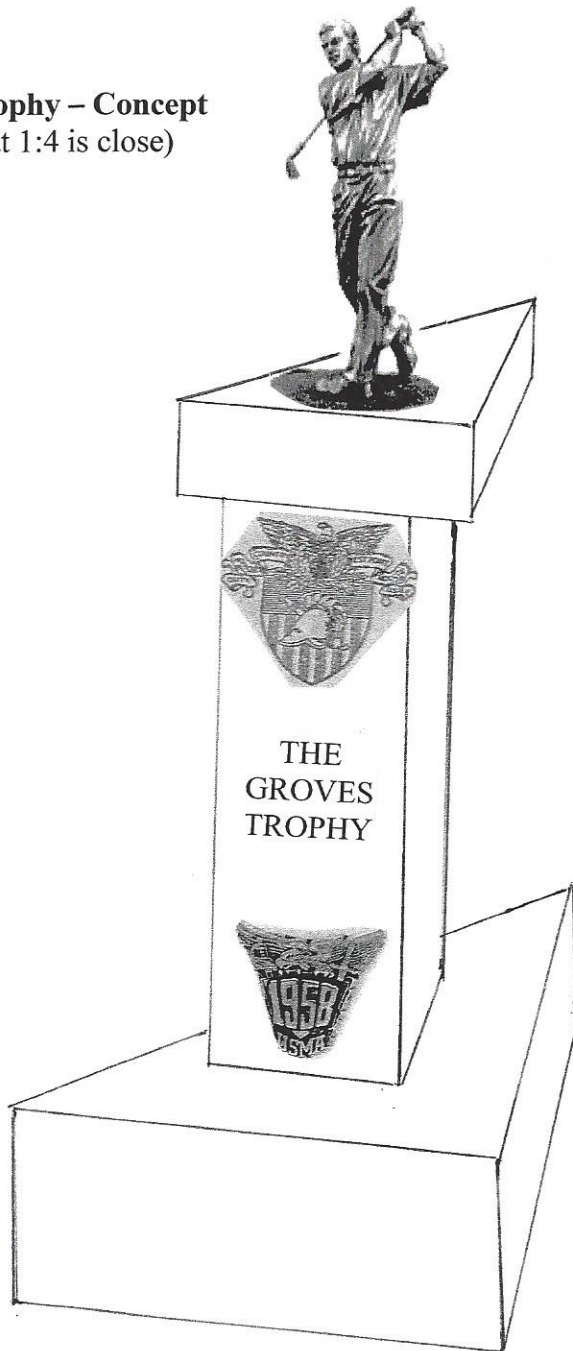


The Groves Trophy – Concept

Presented by the Class of 1958 to Honor

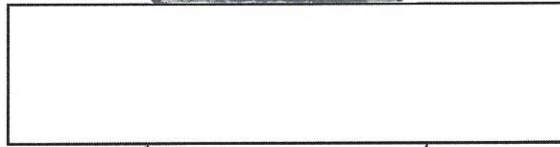

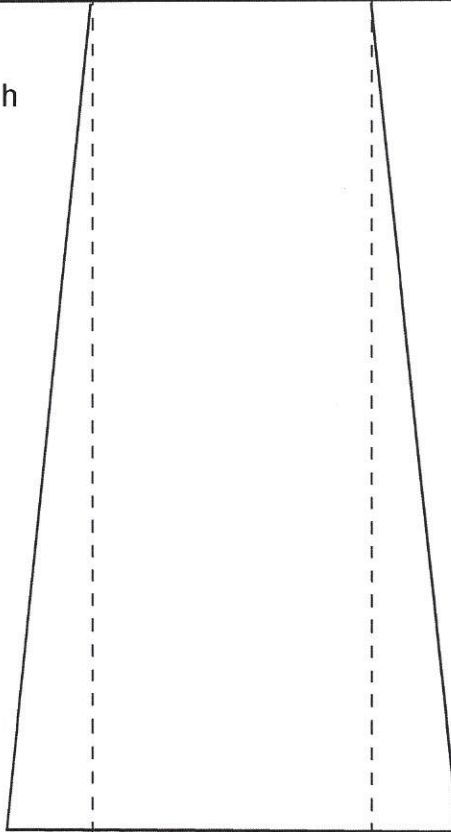
The concept for the trophy is that it will be triangular in shape with the base being approximately 10 inches (3 - 4 inches high) the center section would be 4 inches (12 - 14 inches high) and the top 6 inches (1.5 - 2 inches high). A golf figure (7 - 8 inches in height) would be on top, as depicted. The total height of the trophy would be 24 - 28 inches. The final dimensions of the trophy would be left, in some degree, to the discretion of the artists. I will be working with three different artists regarding final design and materials to be utilized. The golf figure will be of metallic bronze resin. The triangles will be constructed of either all wood material, a combination of a wooden base, metallic center and gray granite top (materials of a type found at West Point) or completely cast in bronze.

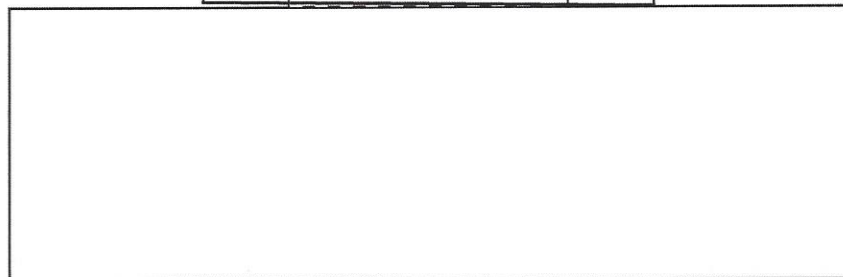

**Individual Trophy
The Groves Tournament**

In addition to having their names inscribed on the permanent Groves Trophy, the individuals whose scores represent the Low Gross and Low Net scores for the tournament will receive an individual trophy as depicted below. At each event an individual may only receive one trophy. If the low gross happens to be the low net as well, the next low net score will be selected. The individual trophy is the same in construction and dimension as the golf figure on the Groves Trophy with the exception that it will be on a wooden base. The plaque on the base will identify the category (gross or net) and the date and place of the event.

The plaque on the front of the trophy will identify the category and event. For Orlando the plaque for Low Net would read:
