Classmates,

Recently Fred Laughlin, our Class Gift Selection Chairman, and the Class Gift Selection Committee finished the selection process for our 50th Reunion Class Gift. The process, which took eight months, was extensive and extremely well done. Because of the manner in which the Class Gift Committee conducted our gift selection process, the Association of Graduates (AOG) is using our class as an example of "how to do" class gift selection. We owe Fred, Tom Barron, Mitch Bonnett, Dan Christman, Ed Knauf, John Mogan, Chuck Moseley and Rollie Stichweh our thanks. Exceptional work!

As Fred stated in his email to the Class, the Center for Oral History (COH), a project initiated by Bob Doughty when he was Head of the History Department, was selected as the <u>primary</u> gift for our 50th Reunion. The Gift Selection Committee chose two specific projects within the COH as our reunion gift - the Viet Nam War Archive (for \$1,000,000) and the Film Production Studio (for \$1,000,000). We are committed to raising \$2,000,000 for the Center for Oral History. Additionally, the Long Gray Line (LGL) Endowment, as an endowment, provides in perpetuity resources to strengthen the bonds that connect graduates to West Point. Because the LGLE also received broad support within the Class, it was selected as a secondary gift, for applying funds raised <u>in excess</u> of the \$2,000,000.

During committee deliberations it was determined that our Class would, in all probability, raise more than \$2,000,000 and a decision was made to apply the funds raised in excess of the \$2,000,000 to the LGL Endowment. One half of excess funds would go to the LGL General Endowment and the other half would go to the Fallen Graduates Memorial Scholarship Endowment which provides scholarships to children of graduates that have been killed in combat. Both of these gifts not only relate well to our Class, they will have a substantial impact on West Point and its alumni. **The goal for the LGL Endowment is \$600,000**.

While we have tried to briefly summarize how the gift selection process was conducted and what the projects are, we STRONGLY suggest you go to http://www.west-point.org/class/usma1965/news/ and again read through Fred's letter and look at the websites he has referenced. The letter and websites provide project descriptions and the rationale used to ensure that our 50th Reunion Gift fits our Class well and is important to the Academy. One last point – the question "Has our Class committed to a goal that is too high?" needs to be addressed. Currently we have raised almost half of the \$2,600,000 total goal (\$2,000,000 for COH / \$600,000 for LGL Endowment) and our formal fundraising campaign has not yet started. As was stated, "the bar has been set high" but it is well within our capability.

Attached is a Fundraising Organizational Chart that consists of six regions headed by Fred Smith, Larry Neal, Steve Harman, Denny Hawker, Steve Ellenbogen and Bill Hecker. Between the six Regional Chairmen and us, we will, over the next few months, call to ask that each of you consider making a substantial gift over the next four plus years. You will be asked to fill out the attached pledge sheet and send it to the Academy. Lastly, the principal Ways to Give are summarized and provided. If you have questions, let us know and we will get answers to any questions you might have.

This will be our last major gift and something that gives back to an institution that has given so much to each of us. Please consider well what you can do. We are "Strength and Drive" and a very special Class!

Credit Card

The following major credit cards are accepted: VISA, MasterCard, and American Express.

Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT)

Donors can make their contributions monthly from a bank account by filling out the form found at the WPAOG website at www.westpointaog.org. Contributions will be automatically deducted from their bank accounts on or about the 15th of each month.

Matching Gifts

Charitable IRA Rollover

The charitable IRA rollover legislation allows you to transfer lifetime gifts <u>up to \$100,000</u> using funds from your individual retirement account (IRA) without having to pay tax on the distribution. **AS OF NOW, THIS OPPORTUNITY IS ONLY AVAILABLE THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011.**

You may contribute funds this way if:

- You are age 70 ½ or older at the time of the gift.
- The gifts total any amount up to \$100,000 in 2011.

Limits on Personal Exemptions and Overall Itemized Deductions

For 2011, you will no longer lose part of your deduction for personal exemptions and itemized deductions, regardless of the amount of your adjusted gross income (AGI).
