AOG still does not intend to open the actual **Reunion Registration** until the end of February. We will send out another letter to let you know the actual date once we are told what that date will be.

Thanks to Jim Harvey's diligent work with the hotel and our Company Reps, we can tell you that close to two hundred rooms have been booked by classmates at the Park Ridge Marriott. The Park Ridge Marriott is now sold out, and additional rooms are being booked at the Courtyard in nearby Montvale, NJ....just five minutes away. If you ended up booking at the

Courtyard because the Park Ridge Marriott is sold out, please let Jim know, as he is keeping a waiting list in case any cancellations at the Marriott occur. By all accounts, it looks like we will have a great turnout, breaking the records on statistics for attendance at a 55th West Point Reunion! Way to go "Strength and Drive!"

HOTEL CANCELLATIONS: It is very important that you do all hotel cancellations through Jim Harvey (cell: 757-288-6684) or email jimjuneh@cox.net. If you deal directly with the hotel or website, the class will likely lose the room, and another classmate won't get the benefit. When Jim cancels the room, he immediately replaces it with a classmate on the waiting list.

HANDICAP ASSISTANCE: If you use a wheelchair or walker, we are told that most people who have such a need usually bring their own equipment. Should you wish to rent a wheelchair or walker once you arrive at the reunion, the AOG Event Planning Staff has a list of providers you can contact. The staff can answer any questions you might have in this regard, so please don't hesitate to contact them.

MEMORABILIA ORDERS: The Memorabilia Committee is in the process of working with the AOG Gift Shop to select memorabilia items for the reunion. Should you wish to order any of these items, you will do so directly through the AOG Gift Shop. They will have the items packaged and ready to distribute to you upon your arrival at the reunion.

<u>VIETNAM COMMEMORATIVE PINS:</u> Across the Nation, a generation of warriors and their families are being publicly thanked and honored for their service and sacrifice during ceremonies hosted by thousands of dedicated Vietnam Commemorative Partners! The West Point Alumnae Glee Club is one of those Partners. Most all our classmates served on active duty during the Vietnam War and are eligible to be presented with an official Vietnam Veteran Lapel Pin. This "lasting memento of the Nation's thanks" is now proudly worn by more than two million previously unheralded patriots! Many of our classmates have already been presented with a pin, but many more have not. If you have not yet received a pin, and would like to receive one at the reunion, please send an email to Nancy Hecker at mancyhecker@mindspring.com so we can get a count of the number of pins we need. These pins will be simply and quietly presented at the end of the Memorial Service on Friday, the "Commemorate" day of the Reunion.
