## **Complete These 5 Steps**

- Provide your Spouse or family with AAFMAA's contact information
- 2. Keep important documents in a safe place and let your family know where they are
- 3. Order at least 10 15 death certificates for Social Security, Insurance Benefits, change of ownerships, access to safety deposit boxes, tax returns (this can be done through the funeral home)
- 4. Let your Spouse or family know that they will need to clip or print obituary notices as some insurance companies require a dated newspaper announcement in order to process the claims
- 5. Be aware of the important documents that AAFMAA Financial Advisors needs in order to process your claims and entitlements:
- DD-214
- Birth Certificates for all dependents
- Marriage Certificate
- Divorce Decree
- Beneficiary date of birth, sex, Social Security numbers, addresses and contact information
- Wills, Living Will
- Power of Attorney, Durable, Medical
- Life Insurance and ANNUITY Policies
- Trust documents (if applicable): Title page, pages naming

trustees, signature page and any full amendments and trust tax ID number

• Certified Death Certificate
