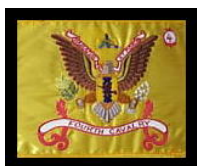

# Andrew Ryan Houghton

September 26, 1978 -  
August 9, 2004

*Describing who Andy was as an Army Officer, West Point Graduate, Person, Man, and Friend is an extremely difficult thing to do! No matter what we say about Andy, it still seems inadequate to anyone that had the honor and privilege of knowing him. Andy was one of those rare people that was able to talk to anyone no matter how young or old, no matter how simple or sophisticated, and make them feel good about themselves. He was a man of vision, character and principle.*

*Andy was a soldier. He was serving his country in Operation Iraqi Freedom when he was mortally wounded by an RPG attack while on patrol July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2004, near Samarra Iraq. Andy survived his injuries for about four weeks before passing away at Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington, D.C. on August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2004. Andy fought a brave fight, served his nation with honor, and gave the ultimate sacrifice on behalf of his nation and freedom for all.*

*The Captain Andrew R. Houghton Foundation was established to honor Andy's memory and his sacrifice by supporting charities and organizations such as **The Captain Andrew R. Houghton Memorial Scholarship at Strake Jesuit College Preparatory, Laity Lodge Youth Camp, Special Olympics New York (West Point Spring Games), Houston Taping For The Blind and Cadets and Cadet Activities at the United State Military Academy.** The "Drive-On" Memorial Golf Tournament is the major annual fundraising event for the foundation.
